I. Work Place Violence: Forewarned is Forearmed. Presenters: Kevin C. Wilkes and Chip Boylan, CPCU. Filed for 3 CE credits, P&C only. This Seminar moves from a history of violence and violence identification to the impact of violence, then to the methodology of identifying at risk industries and danger recognition. Potential solutions will be discussed, and there will be ample time for questions and answers.

II. Flood Insurance. Presenter: Phil Rager, AIC. Filed for 3 CE credits, P&C only. This seminar covers the background and purpose of the NFIP, the flood insurance market and risk assessment, amounts of coverage available, deductible options and a review of the Dwelling and General Property forms.

A workshop on recognizing the perils of replacing ethical actions with legal compliance. In the 16th century Nicco Macchiavelli said: *How we live is so far removed from how we ought to live, that doing what you should instead of what you must will bring about your ruin.* Therefore, it is necessary to learn how not to be good. Is there a gap between compliance with state and federal laws and "doing what you should"? How does this relate to our actions in the 21st century? What are the responsibilities of the insurance industry to the consumer? These topics and more will be the focus in this interactive, workshop.

IV. Risk Management and Insurance for Data Security and Privacy Exposures. Presenter: Nick Economides. Filed for 3 CE credits P&C Only. Costs associated with a data breach can be very significant. This seminar details exposures such as credit card, social security number, driver's license number, banking and employment information, personal health and business information and the type of loss incidents that can occur. Key risk controls and legal issues are discussed along with applicable "Cyber" insurance coverage. There will be ample time for questions and answers.
